# **OVERVIEW**

#### 1. OBJECTIVES

- A. To promote youth exchanges between ASEAN and Korea by forming solidarity and friendly relationships
- B. To develop global leadership of youths through thematic activities and exchanges of shared views and opinions among youths from ASEAN and Korea
- C. To provide youths with the opportunity to make a contribution to the development of the ASEAN-Korean community by exploring a common agenda and drawing cooperative measures

### 2. BACKGROUND

- A. The need to promote exchanges in the youth sector has emerged as a result of strengthened cooperation between ASEAN and the ROK, including the implementation of the New Southern Policy since 2017
- B. Emphasis of participation and cooperation in the field of youth under Article 26 of Co-Chairs' Statement of the 2019 ASEAN-Republic of KOREA Commemorative Summit (Article 26 acknowledges that ASEAN and the ROK continue youth exchanges, strengthening youth cooperation)
- C. Delivering on the plan in an effort to regularize the Youth Summit as the representative international youth event for ASEAN-Korean youths
- D. Establishing online events as an alternative measure to holding offline events due to the COVID 19 situation.
